Samora stands for an energetic, fresh and exciting music experience. Her live performances are cheerful and enthusiastic, her appearance as charming as it is cheerful, her voice powerful and versatile.

The singer combines different musical influences, which are mainly rooted in modern Caribbean rhythms and which melt melody lines and harmonies that break through stylistic boundaries.

Her repertoire includes songs that range from catchy and pumping Reggae tunes to fiery Dancehall- and **Afrobeat tracks**. The Suriname-Dutch artist sweetens this with a good pinch of soul and pop.

Samora enchants her audience with her fresh and appealing style and captivates the crowd with catchy songs and powerful, fat sounds. With her convincing performance and a refreshing and strong stage presence she is an extremely attractive live act.

Biography

Born in 1991 in Paramaribo, Suriname, Samora came into contact with music at a very early age and fell in love with the different sounds and styles she heard, from Gospel to Reggae. Already as a little girl she had the wish to become a singer. When she moved to Holland at the age of 14, she was able to realize her dream and turned to a career in the music business. Between 2012 and 2014 she attended the

Nederlandse Pop Academie in Utrecht, founded her own band and participated in several music competitions, some of which she won.

After her first two singles «Amazing» and «My Turn» in 2015, she turned more and more to Reggae-related music, which was reflected in the 2016 insider tip **«Momma Said»**.

Further singles and first bigger shows in the Netherlands followed until 2018, when she accepted an invitation from the band *Open Season* to be part of the «Female Reggae Voices» tour. Together with the Swiss band she released the tune **«Me Na Fallin»** in 2018.

In spring 2019 her debut album **«Moengo»** was released – a homage to the place where her parents first met. And in 2019 and 2020, Samora released a number of other successful singles such as **«Keep My Fire Lit»**, **«One And Only»** and **«Free Up»** and consistently pursued her path of expanding her fanbase through commitment and convincing live shows. Highlights were for example performances at the renowned **«Reggaelake-Festival»** in Amsterdam dar, but also several memorable gigs in Switzerland.
